The **October 2013 Band Board Minutes** were submitted and approved as written.

**Financial Update:**

- We have collected \$97,518 in trip money. We have \$17,000 in savings. Collected \$1100 in prior years' fees with \$13,633 still owed. 75% of this years' fees have been collected with \$25,867 still outstanding.
- Made \$627 in tips at the Patriots game. Most were very generous especially when they found out we were a HS Band. Going to use the Band signs to help publicize it more. Also going to get hats and visors to let everyone know who we are.

**President's Report:** End of the year party is this Friday. We are a little worried about the rain as we have 180 people coming. We got wood for the bonfire and the wagon rides are set to go. Lynne will send out a reminder email and also remind them to bring chairs.

**Vice President's Report:**

- **Panthers:** YTD - \$11,500 after points. We made \$2693 at the Patriots game and there is a \$416 credit for workers. Thinking about having a Panthers 101 training for new parents next year.
- **Restaurant Nights:** Friday 12/13 at Jason's Deli. It will be from 5-10pm. Our January one will be at Danny's Pizza on 1/15.
- **Fruit and Pastry Sale:** Due to weather the delivery has been delayed to 12/13 and 12/14.
- **Oyster Roast:** Went very well. After points we made \$2999.
- **DVD Sales:** Pre-sale going well. We have 100 to sell. We will distribute them on 12/18 at the concert.

**Band Director's Report:**

- Middle School Concert Festival will be at NFHS. We will need some volunteers to help out. Parking buses will be the most help we need. It will be the week of March 4<sup>th</sup> on Tues, Wed and Thurs.
- There will be some changes in classes next year. South Pointe is going from 4-3, Rock Hill and Clover going from 4-5, Lexington and White Knoll going from 5-4. Fort Mill was # 19 very close to going from 4-5.
- As far as marching goes next year we will be going to Grand Nationals. We will work on the best schedule to give them a good chance at BOA. Bands that do well typically have State contests that are like BOA regionals. Would like to do Western Carolina but that will be determined by their schedule. They must do it

on the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend of their Fall Break. Last year we did Alabama as our Regional and we will look at that possibility for next year.
