Christopher Griffin is a private horn instructor and a freelance musician in the Charlotte area. He holds adjunct faculty positions as instructor of horn at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and Wingate University where he also teaches sight singing and ear training. He is a member of the Western Piedmont Symphony and the Union Symphony Orchestras. He has performed with the Charlotte Symphony, Greenville Symphony and the Charleston Symphony Orchestras. He currently maintains a private horn studio in Fort Mill, South Carolina, coaches chamber music at several local schools and has been on faculty at the Interlochen Center for the Arts Summer Music Festival. He is an active member of the International Horn Society. Dr. Griffin received his DMA from the University of Southern California, MM degrees in music theory and horn performance from Temple University and his BM in horn performance from Auburn University. His primary teachers include Richard Todd, James Decker, Eric Ralske, Randy Gardner, Dr. Randall Faust, Dr. Gayle Chesebro and Aaron Brask.
