The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Stacy Tickle.

The **November Booster Meeting** minutes were read and approved.

Financial Update:

- \$10,662 prior years' fees collected, \$10,662 of current fees still owed.
- \$227,800 collected so far for Hawaii trip. There is \$161,500 still owed. There are 97 students going and 92 tagalongs.
- CHARMS is up to date as of last week and now live.

President's Report:

- Congratulations to all the students that made Region and All State. Region Band will be held here on 2/21 and 2/22. We will need help with concessions and food donated for the Band directors' hospitality room. An email with the sign-up genius will be going out.
- We have 108 possible rising freshman. Recruitment has started and there are 10 volunteers working on it.
- The Hawaii meeting will be at the end of the February booster meeting.

Vice President's Report:

- **NAFO Family Volunteer Participation:** We had help in all the following this year, Exhibition, GPS sale, Medical Tent, Hospitality, Oyster Roast, Uniform, Chaperone, Panthers, Servers, Pit Crew and Fruit and Pastry. We had a total of 210 volunteers or participation total this year. 15 of them were friends or alumni. 195 band family members out of 117 families and 160 students. Many participated in more than one thing. We would like to thank everyone who has helped out so far this year.
- **Panthers:** Thank you very much to everyone that helped out this year in any way that they did. We exceeded our goal for the year. 57 student accounts were credited. 40% of the workers had never worked a game before this year and did great. We are looking for leads, managers and money managers for next year. We made a gross profit of \$27,119 for the year after points. We are looking at a bonus structure for next year. We should know what stand we will have by May. We will also have hats and visors that identify who we are next year. We will be doing a Panthers 101 next year before the season starts.
- **Restaurant Nights:** Danny's Pizza was slow this time and we will be doing Chickfila on 2/19.
- **Fruit and Pastry:** Went very well. We made \$2934.95 after paying out \$404 in points. We sold 217 boxes of fruit and 200 butter braids. 55 students participated.

- **Oyster Roast:** The next Oyster Roast will be on March 15th from 5-8 pm and we will do both types of tickets again.
- **Band DVD:** We sold 74 and there are still some for sale.

Band Director's Report:

- York County Honor band will be this Tuesday and Wednesday. Concert will be on Wednesday at 7pm. We are hosting it here.
- Middle School Concert Festival will be held here and hoping that next year the high school one will be here also.
- Winter Guard season starts this Saturday and they will be performing at Dorman.
- Hawaii-5 groups traveling. We will leave on Wednesday 4/9 and return on Tuesday 4/15 getting here on 4/16. All families will be flying together. Working on the luggage fees and how to pay for that both ways.

- **Band Store:** Going good nothing new at this moment
- **New Business: Nominating Committee** will be headed up by Lynne Hall and Carolyn Wacaster. They are looking for recruits and anyone interested in being on the board.
