June 2014 Band Booster Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: Monday, June 30, 2014
Location: Nation Ford High School

Meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by Lynne Hall.

The May Booster Minutes were submitted and approved as written by Tina Englert and Carolyn Wacaster.

Financial Update:

- There is approximately \$27475 in checking, including today's PayPal deposit of \$5000 and \$17,007 in savings.
- There is \$16,500 in past due money owed. \$7,800 is due from the 2013-14 marching season. \$8,600 is due from 2011-2013.
- Lynne added that \$16,500 may seem like a large number but our total budget is around \$200,000 so it is a small percentage.
- Margaret Marshall was going to talk about Charms but was unable to attend. Lynne informed the club that all information is in Charms and it is up to date. Parents do have to look at two different screens to compare points and fees. The first band fee payment of \$200 is due July 1.
- If you have not logged in recently, please log into Charms to make sure all your information is accurate.

President's Report: Lynne is looking forward to serving as president. If you have any questions, comments, concerns, please contact her. Email blasts will be sent out through Charms. It is the easiest way to get information out to current students and alumni. Use Charms to sign up to work Panthers' games. Tonight, Lynne will be sending out a test email blast, followed by a regular email to verify that you got the first one.

Vice President's Report:

- **Restaurant Nights:** Sweet Frogs is having a week-long event for the band. It will be the week of 7/21-7/25 from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. The band will receive 10% of proceeds. There will probably be a receipt drop box. Chick-fil-a nights start in September. Other restaurants night will be held at Jason's Deli, Midtown Sundries and Danny's.
- **Strawberry Festival:** The band made \$1500 from the Strawberry Festival before points were paid.
- **Panthers:** The club's new stand is 521. It needs fewer volunteers. It has 10 windows, instead of the 14 of the last year's stand. There will be no additional information until the remodeling of the stadium is finished. The stadium will not be open until FanFest so there will be no in stand training. Lisa will be doing some training at school – in the evening the week of Band Camp. This stand will

not be open for FanFest so the first event is a soccer game on 8/2 at 6:30 pm. (Reminder: We arrive 4 hours before the start of the game.) Ron Hall asked about Nation Ford High School Band hats or visors to wear in the stand to increase tips. The visors have been delivered and we will be wearing them this season.

- **Silent Auction:** The silent auction and Italian Dinner will be held on 9/6, most likely from 4:00pm – 7:00pm. There is an all day band practice that day. The dinner will be catered by Maggiano's. The committee is trying to get Cheesecake Factory for dessert. The club is hoping the silent auction and Italian dinner will raise \$10,000. The committee is still collecting donations, if you have any ideas or contacts.

Band Director's Report: Nothing to report at this time.

Committee Updates:

- **Band Store:** The visors (to be worn in the Panthers' stand) were delivered tonight. The club will be getting a PayPal swipe to be used at the silent auction and the band store. The credit card fee will be added to the customer's total.
- **Hospitality:** Tina Englert is back to manage hospitality. She will be sending out an email in two to two and half weeks. She will need people to help prepare and serve lunch and dinner during band camp. The committee is always looking for desserts. The new "no homemade" rule does not apply to band camp. Nation Ford has a new cafeteria manager. Tina will meet with her to make plans. There will most likely be a SignUp Genius for all the volunteers needed during band camp. The band needs lots of bottled water. There are less than 10 cases left from last year. The bottled water is used on competition and travel days.

New Business: No new business.
